Dear Lower Manhattan Resident

Earlier today we were notified that an exceedance for Silica occurred on February 25, 2009 at Station 17 (15th floor scaffold station – NW corner). A result of 13 ug/m³ was recorded – the trigger level is 10 ug/m³.

The Federal Environmental Protection Agency was immediately notified.

Our Environmental consultant believes that based on a review of activities on site and around the site, the exceedance appears to be attributable to off-site activities.
