 - This RFQ is for Printing Services specifically. As a printing broker, you don't qualify as a printing company.
- 2. Where in the RFQ is there a reference to quantities? The New York State Contract Reporter lists publications, newsletters, pamphlets, posters, flyers, booklets, banners, etc.
 - The LMDC has a variety of printing needs, including items such as those mentioned. Detailed quantities are specific to each project, therefore it is difficult to project at this time, however qualifications should include a range of quantities you are able to produce.
- 3. Section B "Fees and Costs", subsection 6 "A schedule of labor costs" is an area that we can not fill out without more detailed specifications. Do you have any suggestion or an idea of what you are looking for?
 - The schedule of labor costs refers to those that will be passed on or charged to LMDC and can be an estimate or range based on the type of work or service provided.
