Questions and answers will be responded to via email on 3/25/08. The bid due date is 3/28/08 by 2 pm.

If you intend to respond to the RFP, a non-binding letter of intent, which will assist in proposal evaluation, must be submitted no later than 3/18/08. Proposals will not be accepted if you do not submit a letter of intent within the specified time period.

Please note that a portion of the funding for the project is from public sources and may require adherence to specific reporting procedures.

Three (3) copies and an electronic (PDF) version of your proposal must be received by 2 pm on 3/28/08. Failure to meet this deadline will disqualify the submission.
